CONTEST RULES

1. The contest runs from Saturday August 1st to September 26th, 2020. Photographs received after midnight on September 26th will not be considered.
2. The theme of the contest is to capture in images how an appreciation of nature and the St. Clair River has helped relieve the stress caused by the Covid-19 pandemic. Subject of photographs is to be the St. Clair River. This may include any activity, scenic view, people, buildings, etc. related to, along, in, under, or from the St. Clair River.
3. The photo contest is open to anyone with exception of FOSCR members, persons on the St. Clair River Remedial Action Plan (RAP) Implementation Committee, and professional photographers.
4. Photos must be submitted in electronic (digital) format via the Friends of the St. Clair website at www.friendsofstclair.ca.
5. Photographs may be submitted in .JPG, .BMP, or .RAW format. File size must not exceed 5 megabytes.
6. Photographers must include their name, address and phone number. Entries without this information will not be considered.
7. Each photographer may submit a maximum of three photographs.
8. All photographs submitted become the property of FOSCR, which reserves the right to use these photographs in the promotional materials supporting the St. Clair River Remedial Action Plan (RAP). All photographs used will be given photo credit.
9. While every precaution will be taken, the contest organizers, sponsors and associates will not be responsible for loss or failure to receive electronic files transmitted over the internet.
10. Selection of the winning photographs will be performed by a panel of judges including members of the FOSCR board of directors and a volunteer local professional photographer. The judging criteria will be visual impact, technical and artistic merit. The decision of the judges will be final.
11. Prizes will be confirmed and publicly announced before October 10th, 2020. Two prizes will be awarded in each contest category (-18 Youth and Adult). Prizes will be of significant value.
12. All contest entrants accept the rules of the contest and agree to abide by them.
