CONTEST RULES

1. The contest runs from September 4th to November 1st, 2024. Photographs received after midnight on November 1st will not be considered.
2. The theme of the contest is to celebrate with photographs the environmental recovery that has occurred on St. Clair River. Subject of photographs is to be the St. Clair River. This may include any activity, scenic view, people, buildings, etc. related to, along, in, under, or from the St. Clair River.
3. The photo contest is open to the public, except for FOSCR members, St. Clair River Canadian Remedial Action Plan (RAP) Implementation Committee members, Binational Public Advisory Council members, and professional photographers.
4. Photos must be submitted in electronic (digital) format to the Friends of the St. Clair River by way of the following email address: rapcoordinator@scrca.on.ca
5. Photographs may be submitted in .JPG, .PNG, or TIFF format. File size must not exceed 5 megabytes.
6. Photographers must include a name, mailing address, phone number, e-mail address, and the name of the category that they wish to have their photograph entered under - Youth (Under 18), Digital Perspectives or Nature & Wildlife. Entries without this information will not be considered.
7. Each photographer may submit a maximum of three photographs.
8. All photographs submitted become the property of FOSCR, which reserves the right to use these photographs in the promotional materials supporting the St. Clair River Remedial Action Plan (RAP). All photographs used will be given photo credit.
9. While every precaution will be taken, the contest organizers, sponsors and associates will not be responsible for loss or failure to receive electronic files transmitted over the internet.
10. Selection of the winning photographs will be performed by a panel of judges including members of the FOSCR board of directors. The judging criteria will be visual impact, technical and artistic merit. The decision of the judges will be final.
11. Prizes will be confirmed and publicly announced before November 15, 2024. Three cash prizes will be awarded in each of three contest categories (Under 18 Youth, Digital Perspectives and Nature & Wildlife). Prizes will be awarded to winners at an Awards Evening event, date and location to be announced.
